

INVESTIGATION OF VEHICULAR CRIME WITH SPECIAL REGARD TO ADOPTING THE NEW MEANS AND METHODS OF FORENSIC SCIENCE

ABSTRACT: *The scientific and technological achievements of the second half of the 20th century - revolutionising science, production and information transfer, altering people's lifestyle in most parts of the world – have inevitably affected jurisdiction as well. It was a two-way affect. On one hand as a negative consequence, delinquency gained a new, dangerous weapon which offers a chance for committing crimes with enormous profit and for making illegal income vanish. On the other hand, as a positive consequence, efficient devices appeared in the armoury of criminalistics.*

Public area delinquency is an important component of vehicular crime and within that especially road traffic offenses of which those causing mayhem (1999: 3615, 2006: 3374, 2009: 2997) and those fatal (1999: 590, 2009: 350) shows decrease in Hungary. Evaluating modern criminalistics devices as evidences is spreading quickly, which are detailed in the article in connection with traffic offenses.
